HOTION FOR A RESOLUTION tabled by Hrs VAN HEHELDONCK pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure on the age of majority

## The European Parliament,

- noting that the national legislation of the Member States lays down when a subject becomes of age under civil and labour law,
- noting that there are significant differences between the Member States on this issue,
- whereas, with a view to further European integration, efforts should be made to harmonize the various legal provisions in this field,
- 1. Calls for the age of majority under civil and labour law to be fixed at 18;
- 2. Calls on the ember States to harmonize their legislation on this basis as quickly as possible;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the Commission and the governments and parliaments of the Member States.
