MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr HABSBURG, Mr d'ORMESSON, Mr ZECCHINO,
Mr KLÉPSCH, Mr PEDINI and Mr WAWRZIK

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on attempted terrorist subversion in the Member States
and various associated countries

The European Parliament,

- A. concerned at the growing number of terrorist outrages foreboding a fresh wave of violence,
 - B. deeply perturbed by terrorist and subversive activities at international level both in the Member States and various associated countries,
 - C. whereas the terrorist movements have been shown to be linked and relations between the undercover organizations of the Eastern bloc states and the areas where terrorism, training camps, the arms trade and subversion develop are aimed at disrupting the political balance within the European Community and at international level,
 - D. whereas this subversive factor and terrorist activity could create an irreversible crisis with tragic consequences,
1. Calls on the Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation to intensify their investigations, to monitor extremely closely the course of events and to take the necessary political and legal measures to prevent any further such machinations which represent a threat to peace and are in breach of Treaties, agreements, the U.N. Charter and the Final Act of Helsinki.
