MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr GLINNE, Mrs MACCIOCCHI, Mr RIPA DI MEANA
and Mr PELIKAN

on behalf of the Socialist Group

with request for topical and urgent debate
pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on repression in Poland

The European Parliament,

- A. concerned at the brutal repression of the workers' demonstrations which took place on May 1 in Poland,
- B. shocked at the death of a young demonstrator at Nova Huta, who was killed by a tear-gas grenade,
- C. concerned at the climate of tension in Poland,
- D. recalling its attachment to respect for human rights throughout the world,
 - 1. Condemns the use of force and the brutal repression of the spontaneous and peaceful movements which occurred in Poland on 1 May;
 - 2. Invites the Polish authorities to enter into a dialogue with the representatives of Solidarnosc without delay with a view to the official recognition of the free trade union;
 - 3. Recalls its attachment to political and trade union pluralism;
 - 4. Requests the Council of Ministers meeting in political cooperation to take all necessary steps to put an end to the present situation in Poland;
 - 5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Polish authorities and to the Council of Ministers.
