# THE HIGH AUTHORITY

#### **INFORMATION**

Communication from the High Authority of the European Coal and Steel Community to Associations of Enterprises coming under the Community's jurisdiction

#### (Article 48 of the Treaty)

In letters addressed to the President of the Consultative Committee on October 6, 1955, the High Authority requested the Committee to proceed to the consultations prescribed

- ---in Article 55, 2 of the Treaty, regarding the advisability of setting aside funds from the levies provided for in Article 50, for the purpose of helping to finance comparative tests with blast-furnace coke;
- ---in Article 53, 1 (a) of the Treaty, regarding the advisability of authorizing the creation, under High Authority control, of financial arrangements common to a number of German enterprises, for compensating the prices of a certain tonnage of coal imported from the United States.

The Associations of Enterprises coming under the jurisdiction of the Community have, under Article 48, 2 of the Treaty, the right to submit to the High Authority the observations of their members on the points for discussion.

Any such observations should reach the High Authority not later than Wednesday, November 9, 1955.

#### ANNOUNCEMENT

#### Grant of financial assistance under Article 55, 2 (c) of the Treaty, for the encouragement of research in the field of industrial health and medicine

After consultation with the Consultative Committee and with the agreement of the Council of Ministers, the High Authority, at its session of October 5, 1955, decided, in accordance with Article 55, 2 (c) of the Treaty, to set aside 300 000 E.P.U. units of account per annum for four years, for the encouragement of various types of research work in the field of industrial health and medicine in the coalmining and iron and steel industries of the Community.

#### Appeal of the "ASSOCIAZIONE INDUSTRIE SIDERURGICHE ITALIANE" (ASSIDER), association with registered offices in Milan, vs the High Authority, filed on September 12th, 1955 (Case No. 11–55)

The "ASSOCIAZIONE INDUSTRIE SIDERURGICHE ITALIANE" (ASSIDER), association with registered offices in Milan filed on September 12th, 1955, with the Registry of the Court of Justice an Appeal against the High Authority of the European Coal and Steel Community requesting annulment of Decision No. 26–55 of July 20th, 1955 (Official Gazette of the Community of July 26th, 1955), and of Decision No. 14–55 of the High Authority, of March 26th, 1955 (Official Gazette of the Community of March 30th, 1955); the association is acting through its chairman Mr. Dandolo Francesco REBUA, represented and assisted, by virtue of an act of procuration of August 31st, 1955, by Professor Cesare GRASSETTI, Barrister in Milan; it has chosen as its address for service the residence of Mr. Guido RIETTI, 15 boulevard Roosevelt, Luxemburg.

Plaintiff requests that it may please the Court

"to annul Decision No. 26-55 of the High Authority of July 20th, 1955, and that part of Decision No. 14-55 of the High Authority, of March 26th, 1955, pertaining to the savings of scrap-iron resulting from an increased consumption of cast iron, and to take at the same time the measures provided for in the Treaty, and, in case of need, to order that the execution of the Decision in question be suspended;

and to condemn Defendant in the costs."

and to condemn Defendant in the costs."
