'The European Parliament,

- A - aware that three journalists : Simon WINCHESTER (Sunday Times), Ian MATHERS and Anthony PRIME (The Observer) are being held by the Argentinian authorities in USHUALA, TERRA DEL FUEGO, accused of breaches of the country's security laws,
- B - noting that all three were arrested on April 13 while on a normal journalistic assignment,
- C - believing that the judicial process as conducted to date has been correct as well as being impressed at the considerate treatment given the three journalists while in custody,
1. Calls on the United Nations, the United States of America, the Council and Commission to obtain reassurances from the Argentinian authorities that their personal safety will continue to be protected.'
