on the establishment of a Centre for Friendship  
amongst the Peoples and the Promotion of Studies  
on the Resistance against Nazism at ANOGIA, Crete

The European Parliament,

- a) wishing to celebrate the 37th anniversary of the end of the second World War, a war which cost of millions of human lives, caused enormous suffering and represented for mankind and his democratic institutions the greatest ordeal in history,
  - b) believing that anti-fascist solidarity must remain alive among all peoples who aspire to a world free from violence, oppression, hardship and fear, peoples who were former enemies and are now united in a common struggle,
  - c) seeking to broaden communications between peoples who today feel the same anxiety faced with the threat of war and who share the same hope for a permanent peace,
  - d) responding to the proposal made by the Mayor of Anogia, Crete, a town entirely destroyed by Hitler's occupying forces on an island that was the theatre of one of the greatest battles of the second World War, a town which typifies the heroism shown by dozens of other towns throughout Europe;
1. Has decided to request the Commission to set up in Anogia, Crete, through the European Foundation, a Centre for Friendship and Cooperation between Peoples, untrammelled by ideological barriers, and for the Promotion of Studies on the Resistance against Nazism;
  2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the President of the Commission and to the Governments and Parliaments of the Member States.
