'The European Parliament,

- A - deploring the loss of life in the conflict in the South Atlantic,
- B - recognizing that this loss of life is due to the failure of the Argentine to comply with Resolution 502 of the Security Council of the U.N.,
1. Reaffirms its resolution of 22 April 1982;
 2. Calls attention in particular to paragraph 4 of that resolution, which stressed the need to maintain the Community embargos on Argentina until Resolution 502 is implemented;
 3. Urges the Foreign Ministers meeting in political co-operation to keep constantly in mind that what is at stake in the Falklands conflict is the rule of international law, the authority of the United Nations and the solidarity of the Community;
 4. Instructs its President to forward this Resolution to the Council, the Commission, the Ministers meeting in political co-operation and the Secretary-General of the United Nations.'
