on the FALKLAND ISLANDS

The European Parliament,

- A. confirming the condemnation of the Argentine armed coup in the Falkland Islands,
- B. extremely concerned at the escalation of the Anglo-Argentine armed conflict,
- C. dismayed at the enormous loss of human lives,
- D. convinced that the use of force increases the international tension and instability and that any dispute must be settled in a peaceful manner by diplomatic negotiations and talks,
 - 1. Calls for an immediate end to the armed engagement between the United Kingdom and Argentina in the South Atlantic and the withdrawal of the respective armed forces;
 - 2. Calls on the parties concerned to seek a peaceful solution to the current crisis by entering into negotiations on the basis of United Nations resolution No. 502;
 - 3. Calls on the Foreign Affairs Ministers of the Community meeting in political cooperation (a) not to renew the embargo on Argentine imports due to expire on 17 May 1982 and (b) to play an active part in seeking peaceful solutions, supporting any current attempts at mediation, in particular that undertaken by Mr Perez de Cuellar, United Nations Secretary-General;
 - 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the Commission, the Foreign Affairs Ministers meeting in political cooperation and the United Nations Secretary-General.
