The European Parliament,

- alarmed by the dramatic turn of events in Poland as a result of the extensio. of martial law and the internment of Lech Wallesa and the sands of trade union leaders since 13 December 1981,
- Calls for the immediate release of LECH WAZESA, Chairman of the independent trade union SOLIDARNOŚĆ, and the other imprisoned or interned trade union activists;
- Calls for an end to martial law and to the ban on trade union activities, so that the dialogue between the authorities, the Church and SOLIDARNOŚĆ may be resumed;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council of Ministers and the Polish authorities.
