on the release of Lech WAŁĘSA and Polish trade  
union activists

The European Parliament,

- alarmed by the dramatic turn of events in Poland as a result of the extension of martial law and the internment of Lech Wałęsa and thousands of trade union leaders since 13 December 1981,
- 1. Calls for the immediate release of LECH WAŁĘSA, Chairman of the independent trade union SOLIDARNOŚĆ, and the other imprisoned or interned trade union activists;
- 2. Calls for an end to martial law and to the ban on trade union activities, so that the dialogue between the authorities, the Church and SOLIDARNOŚĆ may be resumed;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council of Ministers and the Polish authorities.
