MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr RADOUX
on behalf of the Socialist Group,

with request for topical and urgent debate
pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the implementation of the EEC/Yugoslavia
agreement

The European Parliament,

- whereas the commitments entered into by the Community when the EEC/Yugoslavia cooperation agreement was signed must be respected;
 - whereas, following the signature of the cooperation agreement with Yugoslavia in Belgrade on 2 April 1980, the terms of the agreement have not been adequately implemented, so that the hopes raised have been disappointed;
 - having regard to the particularly urgent need for practical decisions to be taken to ensure that the terms of the agreement are respected;
1. Expresses its disapproval of the attitude taken by the Council of Ministers at its meeting of 26 October 1981, which did not follow the line taken by the Commission.
 2. Requests the Council, with a view to restoring as far as possible the balance of trade between the two parties, to find a solution that takes due account of the real needs and possibilities of Yugoslav exports to the EEC.
 3. Emphasizes that it is absolutely essential that certain Member States ratify the agreement without delay.
 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council.
