MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr MAFFRE-BAUGE, Mr ANSART, Mrs DE MARCH,
Mr DENIS, Mr MARTIN, Mr PRANCHERE, Mr PIQUET

with request for an early vote
pursuant to Rule 47(5) of the Rules of Procedure

at the end of the debate on oral question 1-146/80

on the need for an early adoption of the budget
after the European Council meeting

The European Parliament,

- in view of the unjustified refusal of the governments of the EEC to decide on an adequate increase in agricultural prices,
 - in view of the continually increasing costs with which farmers have to contend and which, moreover, have increased even faster during the first quarter of 1980,
1. Is in favour of an increase in agricultural prices which makes allowance for the increase in production costs, the rate of inflation and the legitimate claims of the trade organizations, namely 7.9%, to which national measures, particularly in the monetary sphere, would be added thus signifying a 13% increase in agricultural prices for France;
 2. Supports the powerful and determined struggle by the farmers to obtain this increase;
 3. Urges the Council of Agriculture Ministers of the EEC to pronounce itself in favour of such an increase without delay.
