on the setting up of an ad hoc committee on infringements of human rights in the European Community.

The European Parliament,

- deeply concerned at the persistent violations of human rights within the Member States of the Community,
- of the opinion that such violations are contrary, in particular to the constitutions of the various Member States and to the European Convention on Human Rights,
- aware furthermore that human rights include economic and social rights, the right to employment, housing and health care,
- 1. Decides to set up an ad hoc committee to investigate violations of human rights in the nine member countries of the European Community and the European institutions and to report to the European Parliament on appropriate methods of putting a stop to such violations.
