MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr ANGEMANN, Mr DONNEZ, Mr BERKHOUWER,

Democratic Group

with request for topical and urgent debate  
pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the situation in the Lebanon

The European Parliament,

- A. gravely concerned at Israel's military action in the Lebanon,
- B. appalled at the number of civilian casualties,
- C. deploring the terrorist attacks on Israeli citizens which gave rise to Israel's military action,
- D. dismayed at the inability of the West to exert any significant influence over developments in the conflict,
- E. recalling its resolutions of 10.4.1981 and 22.4.1982 noting that 'Lebanon's territorial integrity and national sovereignty are essential for peace in the Middle East' and insisting 'that the sovereignty of the Lebanese Government be restored over the whole of the country and that all foreign armed forces be withdrawn from Lebanon;'
  - 1. Calls upon all sides in the conflict to observe an immediate cease-fire;
  - 2. Insists on the need for all non-Lebanese armed forces to withdraw from the Lebanon, including those of the PLO;
  - 3. Stresses the value, as demonstrated by present events, of the Camp David agreements as a method of bringing about peace in the conflict between Israel and its neighbouring countries;
  - 4. Believes the only basis for peace in the Middle East to be mutual recognition of Israel's right to security and the Palestinians' right to self-determination;
  - 5. Requests that the European Community make every effort to help the civilian victims of the war;
  - 6. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, Council and the Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation.
