on the plight of nomads in the Karamoja region

The European Parliament,

- deeply concerned at the deterioration of the situation in the region of Karamoja, in North-East Uganda, where 400,000 nomadic herdsmen risk death by famine, disease or violence, as a result of the political and military situation,
- recalling its Resolution of 27 April 1979<sup>1</sup> on the need to provide urgent humanitarian aid to the people of Uganda,

1. Approves the action so far undertaken by the Community to help the people of Uganda;
2. Asks the Council, the Commission and the Member States, nevertheless, to take additional measures to deal with the grave situation at present facing Uganda;
3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the Commission and the Member States.
