with request for urgent debate pursuant to Rule 14 of the Rules of Procedure

on the forthcoming meeting of the Council of Ministers for Education

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the resolution of the European Parliament of November 1975¹,
- 1. Welcomes the fact that the date of the meeting of the Council of Ministers for Education has been fixed;
- 2. Deplores the fact that it was not shown the papers relevant to the agenda of the Council of Ministers and insists that in future the directly elected European Parliament should always be enabled to give its views in good time;
- 3. Stresses that the previous European Parliament has already given its opinion on former communications from the Commission to the Council on:
- language teaching
- the encouragement of teaching in schools on the European Community and Europe
- the admission of students to institutes of higher education in other Member States

and is generally in agreement with the views expressed;

- 4. Asks that the measures intended to aid the passage from study to employment should be retained and extended;
- 5. Insists that all the various parts of the programme adopted in the 1976 Council resolution should be implemented fully and with all due speed, and calls upon the Council of Ministers, as set out in the resolution itself, to monitor implementation periodically and to report to Parliament:
- 6. Insists that the Commission and the Council shall henceforth give due consideration to the views of Parliament on the importance of educational and cultural policy when preparing the 1981 Community budget;
- 7. Reserves the right to state its opinion at an early date on the other topics which the Council might be considering;
- 8. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and the Commission.

JUSTIFICATION

The meeting of the Council of Ministers for Education has been fixed for 27 June 1980.
