<u>Subject</u>: Proposal for a Council regulation (EEC) laying down, in respect of hops, the amount of aid to producers for the 1979 harvest (COM(80) 262 final)

Dear Sir Henry,

The Committee on Budgets considered the above proposal for a regulation at its meeting of Monday, 16 June 1980.

The annual fixing of production aid in respect of the 1979 harvest is determined by the market situation, the average yield and price trends within and outside the Community.

The amount of aid has been fixed as follows:

- Aromatics 250 ECU/ha

- Bitters 200 ECU/ha

- Others 250 ECU/ha

On the basis of the areas under cultivation this would give an expenditure under Article 732 of the Community budget of 5.6 m ECU. The appropriation entered in the budget is 10 m ECU.

Since the intervention operations in this sector are declining (in 1978 they amounted to 11.1 m EUA) and the possibility exists that in the event of structural surpluses or market disturbances the aid granted can be restricted to a certain area under cultivation, the Committee on Budgets approves the aid fixed for the year under consideration.
