MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

pursuant to Rule 25 of the Rules of Procedure
on the situation in San Salvador

The European Parliament,

- whereas, following the assassination of Bishop Arnulfo Romero, repression in San Salvador has become increasingly savage and widespread, claiming on average more than forty victims a day,
 - whereas the military government, together with its few civilian supporters, are opposed by all political movements representative of democracy, as well as by all the trade union organizations,
 - whereas there is a danger that the country will be plunged into a bloody civil war,
1. Expresses its solidarity with the people of El Salvador in their struggle to overturn the forces of repression and re-establish democracy;
 2. Calls upon the Member States of the Community to condemn and to isolate the junta that presently holds power;
 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and the Commission of the European Communities.
