on the situation in El Salvador

The European Parliament,

- outraged by the merciless repression of the people of El Salvador which at present is claiming scores of victims daily among the civil population of that country,
  - hoping fervently to see true democracy established in El Salvador at the earliest opportunity,
  - whereas the military junta depends for its survival largely on external economic and military support, mainly from the United States,
1. Vigorously condemns the repressive attitude of the present government of El Salvador as the principal culprit in the slaughter of civilians throughout the country;
  2. Urges the Council and the Governments of the Member States of the Community to cancel all economic and military aid until the present repression in El Salvador comes to an end;
  3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and to the Governments of the Member States.
