on the neutron bomb

The European Parliament,

- determined to support a policy of peace in the world,
- having previously expressed its disapproval of arms proliferation,
- accepting its position of being able to bring important matters to the attention of the world,
- noting the decision of the USA not to produce a neutron bomb and hoping that this position will be maintained,

1. Notes with alarm reports that the French Government has taken a decision to produce a neutron bomb;
2. Deplores such a decision being made by the government of any Member State, and calls on the French Government to note the views of this Parliament and reconsider its plan to produce such a terrible weapon.

Justification

Urgent procedure is justified by the reported decision of the French Government to produce neutron bombs.
