on aid to Poland

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the current economic and food supply situation in Poland,
- having regard to the resolution tabled by Mr PENDERS on human rights in Poland,
 1. Approves wholeheartedly of, and congratulates the Commission on, its favourable response to the Polish's Government's request for consignments of foodstuffs;
 2. Requests the Commission to consider the problem of economic and financial relations between the EEC and Poland in the longer term, and to submit proposals to the Council on the subject;
 3. Looks to the Council to lay down the terms for financial aid, especially for the granting of loans, and therefore requests the Member States to provide the Commission with all the necessary information on their own actions, in order that it may coordinate them;
 4. requests the Commission to report to Parliament on the outcome of its deliberations and the general tenor of its proposals;
 5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, Commission and Foreign Ministers of the Member States.

JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST FOR URGENT PROCEDURE

The developments in Poland vitally affect East-West relations in general and the progress of détente in Europe. In accordance with the principles of the final act of Helsinki, all possible cooperation must be provided to safeguard the independence and development of each country.
