MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr A. LOMAS, Mr CABORN, Mrs BUCHAN, Mr SEAL, Mr GALLAGHER

pursuant to Rule 25 of the Rules of Procedure

on El Salvador

The European Parliament,

- noting that since its motion on El Salvador was passed in April 1980, thousands of citizens in El Salvador have been killed, according to the Catholic Legal Aid Office by military and para-military forces of the government,
- noting the continuing repression and violation of human rights and the growing number of refugees,
- noting the decision of the military junta not to hold elections until 1983,
- noting the report by Amnesty International that the daily atrocities are government authorised,
- 1. Calls on the Commission and the Council of Ministers to ensure that no economic or military aid is sent to the present government of El Salvador:
- 2. Opposes any intervention direct or indirect by any foreign power;
- 3. Calls on financial institutions including the IMF and the World Bank not to extend financial support which could prolong the present civil war;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this Resolution to the appropriate bodies.
