Subject: A strategy to cope with the difficulties experienced by the European car industry

In order to cope with the difficulties experienced by the European industry in the face of the technological and commercial breakthrough achieved by Japan, can the Commission not propose tougher tradelinked measures to safeguard the European market?

Has it yet been able to evaluate the effect of the commercial breakthrough by Japanese car manufacturers on the European countries' share of the markets both in the Community and in the world?

Furthermore, would the Commission not agree that, since the structure of the European industry is characterized by a highly developed system of subcontracting, it enjoys an important advantage that should not be sacrificed in the bid to achieve, at any price, a concentration of technological
