MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION tabled by Mr HERMAN

pursuant to Rule 25 of the Rules of Procedure

on the protection of migratory birds in the Atlantic corridor

The European Parliament,

- whereas migratory birds and in particular waders, thrushes and larks,
 are being destroyed or captured in excessive numbers during their
 passage through the Atlantic corridor,
- whereas the percentage of birds destroyed is substantial, with a consequent risk in the long term of a progressive reduction in the numbers of these species,
- whereas there are differences between the laws of individual countries and whereas these laws are applied in different ways with different penalties,
- whereas it is in the interest of all European citizens, regardless of their nationality, to enjoy the benefits of an environment where natural balances are maintained,
- 1. Requests the Commission to:
- (a) take the initiative by undertaking a study of this problem and its recent development:
- (b) propose to the Member States a procedure to harmonize laws in order to reduce the numbers of migrant birds destroyed or captured in the Atlantic corridor;
- (c) take steps leading to the abolition of the hunting and capture of larks throughout the whole of Europe;
- (d) keep Parliament informed of the action taken in response to this request;
- Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission,
