MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr ALMIRANTE, Mr ROMUALDI,  
Mr BUTTAFUOCO and Mr PETRONIO

pursuant to Rule 25 of the Rules of Procedure  
on the earthquake which has devastated the  
southern regions of Italy

The European Parliament,

- deeply disturbed by the disaster which has struck the southern regions of Italy, causing many victims and damage on an extensive scale,
  - having regard to the vital need for urgent Community aid on a priority basis for the areas and inhabitants affected,
  - having regard to the poverty-stricken nature of the areas devastated by this natural disaster,
1. Calls upon the Council and Commission to intervene with the necessary and most appropriate resources and with the utmost rapidity, and through the agency of international bodies such as the Red Cross, to bring assistance to the populations affected and to expedite the work of reconstruction;
  2. Instructs its President to forward this motion for a resolution to the Council and Commission.
