- if it is aware of the foreseeable consequences of this crisis for the economies and societies of the individual countries and whether it intends to take coordinated measures to put European manufacturers over a certain period of time in a position where they can compete and maintain levels of employment;
- 2. whether it would support moves by Parliament, possibly pursuant to Article 235 of the Treaty of Rome, to include in the 1981 budget appropriations for financing measures to assist with research, industrial reorganization and the retraining of labour?
