MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr GLINNE

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on the exchange rate of the dollar and the need to create a European Currency

The European Parliament,

- A. noting the monetary policy pursued by the Reagan Administration,
- B. noting the re-election of President Reagan,
- C. fearing that the Reagan Administration may continue its present monetary policy,
- D. noting that the high exchange-rate of the dollar is adversely affecting the European economy,
- E. noting that in view of the aggressiveness of the dollar Europe must strengthen its common monetary policy,
- Requests the Council of Ministers for Foreign Affairs to urge the President of the United States to review and change his monetary policy fundamentally;
- 2. Requests the Council of Ministers for Finance to consider the opportunities for creating a single European currency to enable the Member States to conduct commercial transactions with non-member countries in one and the same currency throughout the Community;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission and the Council of Ministers and to the Ministers for Economic Affairs and Ministers for Finance of the Ten.
