SECTION I PARLIAMENT

JUSTIFICATION

One half of the appropriations for the ECSC auditor are shown in the estimates of the Council and the other half in the estimates of Parliament. In June, Parliament entered the same figure as last year. These appropriations must now be modified on the basis of the proposals made by the ECSC auditor and on the basis of the draft budget established by the Council.
