PREPARATION FOR THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL

The Council prepared the items of an economic, financial and monetary nature likely to be raised at the next European Council meeting on 28 and 29 June 1982 in Brussels. These included the economic and social situation and investment in the Community.

The Council had a preliminary exchange of views on the Commission communication on the problem of investment in the Community and asked the Commission to take account of the views expressed when drawing up its report to the European Council. It agreed to continue examining this communication in the light of the European Council's discussions.

EXPORT CREDITS

The Council reached agreement on the Community position with regard to Mr WALLEN's proposal relating to the amendment of the Arrangement on Guidelines for export credits ⁽¹⁾.

⁽¹⁾ One delegation signified its agreement only ad referendum.

INSURANCE

The Council resumed its proceedings on the proposal for a second Directive on the co-ordination of laws, regulations and administrative provisions relating to direct insurance other than life assurance and laying down provisions to facilitate the effective exercise of freedom to provide services and the tax aspects.

The Council considered the conditions of admission and operation peculiar to the freedom to provide services. First of all it examined the definition of large risks - for which the principle of some relaxation was accepted - and in particular the questions of the inclusion of classes, the principle of the introduction of thresholds and their possible level, the inclusion of the professions and the special arrangements to be applied to these large risks. Finally it reviewed the arrangements applicable to small risks.

The Council instructed the Permanent Representatives Committee to continue proceedings in this connection in the light of the day's discussions.

As regards the tax aspects, the Council reached agreement in principle - subject to agreement on the "insurance" question as a whole - that right of option be granted to the Member States with regard to the application of VAT to the insurance transactions in question, provided that the deduction of input taxes did not give rise to distortion of competition between insurers from the Member States or to significant budgetary losses.

It asked the Commission to submit a proposal to it along these lines.

It was understood that this agreement in principle did not prejudge the solution to be adopted in order to bring about the above two conditions (no distortion of competition, no significant budgetary losses).

HARMONIZATION OF COMPANY LAW: CONSOLIDATED ACCOUNTS

The Council took note of a statement by Mr NARJES, Commissioner, drawing its attention to the problems posed by the Commission proposal for a seventh Directive, based on Article 54(3)(g) of the EEC Treaty on consolidated accounts for undertakings.

This seventh Directive should be the follow-up to the fourth Directive on annual accounts which the Council adopted in 1978. In the programme for the harmonization of company law, the adoption of this Directive is a priority. The adoption of a common approach in this connection was essential moreover for current negotiations in this area topic both within the OECD and the UN.

The aim of the Directive is to require major groups to consolidate their accounts in accordance with the provisions which it lays down. The definition of the scope of the Directive or in other words the extent of the consolidation was therefore of primary importance.

The Council stressed the importance which it attached to this matter and agreed to assign top priority to proceedings in this connection and to continue them at its meeting on 12 July 1982.

Le Conseil commence lundi à Luxembourg à midi, après que les ministres se soient réunis à 11 h en leur qualité de gouverneurs de la BEI. Il y a quatre points à l'ordre du jour :

1. assurance directe autre que l'assurance sur la vie
(R.Elphick)

Les ministres vont procéder à un reexamen des problèmes de la libre prestation des services dans le domaine de l'assurance autre que sur la vie. Il y a déjà eu nombre de discussions sur la proposition de 2ème directive de la Commission. Lors des discussions de lundi, les ministres se concentreront plus particulièrement sur la définition des risques de masse et l'application de la directive à ces derniers et sur le problème de l'application de la TVA aux contrats en question.

2. Harmonisation des comptes consolidés

Otto von Schwerin vous fera parvenir lundi une BIO d'explication à ce sujet.

3. Credits à l'exportation

A l'issue du dernier Conseil, la Commission avait reçu mandat d'une part de faire des sondages quant au contenu du compromis Wallen et, d'autre part, de demander aux partenaires du consensus de reporter toute décision au 15 juin ce qui avait été accepté.

La Commission estime que c'est sur base de sa dernière proposition que doit reprendre la discussion des ministres lundi.

4. Preparation des points de caractère économique financier et monétaire susceptibles d'être évoqués lors du prochain Conseil européen

Sous ce point aura lieu d'une part une communication orale du vice-président Ortoli sur la situation économique et sociale dans la Communauté et, d'autre part, un tour de table sur la communication de la Commission au Conseil sur le problème de l'investissement (voir COM(82)365 final) du 8 juin dernier qui vous a été envoyé.

POINT ASSURANCE: AFTER MEETING IN RESTRICTED SESSION UNDER THEIR EUROPEAN INVESTMENT BANK HATS: THE MINISTERS OF FINANCE STARTED THE ECOFIN COUNCIL PROPER AT HALF PAST TWELVE BY EXAMINING THE STATE OF THE DOSSIER ON INSURANCE AND THE PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH FULFILLING TREATY OBLIGATIONS TO PERMIT FREEDOM OF SERVICES. SOME PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE IN RECONCILING DIFFERING POINTS OF VIEWS BETWEEN THOSE MEMBER STATES FAVOURING STRICT SUPERVISION AND THOSE LIKE THE BRITISH AND THE DUTCH FAVOURING THE FREEEST POSSIBLE REGIME. HOWEVER THERE IS A LONG WAY STILL TO GO.


IN HIS OPENING REMARKS VICE PRESIDENT CHRISTOPHER TUGENDHAT REMINDED THE MINISTERS THAT IT IS SIX MONTHS SINCE THE SUBJECT WAS LAST TREATED. IN GENERAL THE COMMISSION COULD ALIGN ITSELF WITH THE EFFORTS MADE BY THE PRESIDENCY TO REACH A COMPROMISE. ALTHOUGH HE SAID THAT THE PROPOSED DIRECTIVE MUST DO NOTHING TO CALL IN QUESTION THE FREEDOMS TO PROVIDE SERVICES ENSHRINED IN ARTICLES 59 AND 60 OF THE ROME TREATY. MINISTERS THEN BEGAN DISCUSSING THE COMPROMISE PROPOSALS.


THE DISCUSSIONS HOWEVER RAN INTO CONSIDERABLE DIFFICULTIES AND
