<u>Subject</u>: Report on the opening, allocation and management of the Community tariff quota in 1975 for frozen beef and veal falling within Common Customs Tariff heading No O2.01 A II (a) 2

Article 6 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 3258/74 of 19 December 1974 opening, allocating and providing for the administration of a Community tariff quota for frozen beef and veal falling within subheading 02.01 A II (a) 2 of the Common Customs Tariff (1975) provides that the Commission shall, not later than 1 October 1975, submit to the Council a report on the quantities for which licences have been issued in each Member State and that the Council, acting by a qualified majority on a proposal from the Commission, shall reallocate any unused quantities.

The information at present available to the Commission shows that :

- as of the end of September 1975 import licences have been allocated to operators in respect of almost 100 % of the tariff quota;
- licences have been actually issued to carry out imports in respect of 30 819 m.t. during the period from 10 January 1975 to 31 August 1975, namely 60 % of the total quantities provided for. Information on Italian imports is at present awaited;
- at the 244th meeting of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal representatives of Member States stated that the remainder would be issued between now and the end of the year.

For these reasons the Commission considers it unnecessary to make any further allocation under this quota.
