## COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

concerning the arrangements applicable to imports into the Community of products originating in the Republics of Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia and Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia

Amended proposal for a
COUNCIL REGULATION (EC) 94/0252 (ACC)
establishing ceilings and Community surveillance for imports of certain products originating in the Republics of Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia and Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (1995)

On 22 December 1993 the Council adopted Regulation (EEC) No 3698/93 concerning the arrangements applicable to the import of products originating in the Republics of BosniaHerzegovina, Croatia, Slovenia and the territory of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia. 1

The Regulation maintained for 1994 preferential trade arrangements in favour of the Republics equivalent to those contained in the EEC-Yugoslavia Cooperation Agreement, denounced by the Community.

Decision 93/732/ECSC of the Representatives of the Governments of the Member Siates meeting within the Council ${ }^{1}$ made similar provisions for products covered by the ECSC Treaty.

The Regulation and Decision were supplemented by implementing Regulations (EC) Nos 652/94 and 653/94 of 21 March 19942 to administer the tariff ceilings and quotas.

The import arrangements provided for by these Regulations and this Decision should therefore be maintained in 1995. The only amendments required concern adjustments to the tariff ceilings and the grouping together in consolidated texts of provisions covering both EC and ECSC products.

Accordingly, the Commission is putting before the Council:
~ an amended proposal for a Council Regulation (EC) concerning the arrangements applicable to the import into the Community of products originating in the Republics of BosniaHerzegovina, Croatia and Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (EC and ECSC products);
~ an amended proposal for a Council Regulation (EC) establishing ceilings and Community surveillance for imports of certain products originating in the Republics of Croatia, BosniaHerzegovina, Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (1995) (EC and ECSC products);
~ a proposal for a Council Regulation (EC) opening and providing for the administration of Community tariff quotas for certain products originating in the Republics of Croatia, BosniaHerzegovina, Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (1995) (agricultural products).

## THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,


#### Abstract

Whereas Council Regulation (EC) No 3698/933 and Decision 93/732/ECSC established the arrangements applicable to imports into the Community of products originating in the Republics of Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Slovenia and the territory of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia;

Whereas these measures should be maintained for 1995, subject to adaptation of the annexes; Whereas the Cooperation Agreement between the European Community and the Republic of Slovenia and the Agreement between the Member States of the European Coal and Steel Community and the European Coal and Steel Community, of the one part, and the Republic of Slovenia, of the other part, signed in Luxembourg on 5 April 1993, which define in particular the trade arrangements between the European Community and Slovenia, provide that the Community shall establish the import tariff arrangements for certain products listed in the Annexes to the Agreements,


HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

## Article 1

Subject to the special provisions laid down in Articles 2 to 8, products other than those listed in Annex II to the Treaty establishing the European Community and in Annex A to this Regulation, originating in the Republics of Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia and Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, shall be admitted for import into the Community without quantitative restrictions or measures having equivalent effect and with exemption from customs duties and charges having equivalent effect.

This Article shall be without prejudice to the provisions contained in Article 3 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 990/93 and Decision 93/235/ECSC of 26 April 1993 concerning trade between the European Economic Community and the European Coal and Steel Community and the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro). 4

## Article 2

The import duties, namely the customs duties and levies (variable components) applicable on import into the Community of the products listed in Annex B shall be those indicated for each product in the said Annex.

## Article 3

1. The import of products listed in Annexes C I, C II, C III, C IV and C V shall be subject, from 1 January to 31 December, to annual ceilings, indicated for each product, above which the customs duties actually applied in respect of third countries may be reintroduced in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2.
2. As soon as a ceiling set for the import of a product has been reached, the Commission may reintroduce, by means of a regulation, the levying of the customs duties referred to in paragraph 1 until the end of the calendar year.

## Article 4

1. In respect of products listed in Annex D originating in the Republics referred to in this Regulation, customs duties on imports into the Community shall be reduced to the levels indicated in the said Annex for each product.
2. In the case of products for which annual tariff quotas are indicated in Annex $D$, these reduced levels shall be granted within the limits of the quotas.

For quantities imported in excess of the quota, the Community shall apply the customs duties actually applied in respect of third countries.
3. For the purposes of reduction of the customs duties in respect of certain products listed in Annex D originating in the Republics referred to in this Regulation, an annual reference quantity is set out in the said Annex.
4. For tobacco of the "Prilep" type falling within CN codes ex 24011060 and ex 24012060 originating in and coming from the Republics concerned, paragraphs 1 and 2 shall apply within the limits of an annual tariff quota of 1500 tonnes.
5. For plum spirit marketed under the name of "Sljivovica" falling within CN code ex 22089033 , paragraphs 1 and 2 shall apply within the limits of an annual quota of 5420 hl .
6. For sweet cherries, clear flesined, preserved in alcohol and intended for the manufacture of chocolate products, falling within CN code ex 20086039 , originating in the Republics concerned, paragraphs 1 and 2 shall apply within the limits of an annual tariff quota of 3000 tonnes.

## Article 5

1. For sour cherries falling within CN codes 08092020,08092060 , ex 08119010 , ex 08119030,08119075 , ex $08121000,20086051,20086061,20086071$ or 20086091 originating in the Republics concerned, the customs duties payable shall be those referred to in Annex D.
2. Paragraph 1 shall apply within the limits of ceilings of 3000 tonnes for sour cherries falling within CN codes 08092020 and 08092060 and 19900 tonnes for sour cherries falling within the other CN codes referred to therein. Where these ceilings are exceeded, the issuing of the import certificates provided for in respect of the products concerned may be suspended.

Paragraph 1 shall apply to sour cherries falling within CN codes ex 08119010 , ex $08119030,08119075,20086051,20086061,20086071$ or 20086091 on condition that the minimum import price set by the Community is applied. Where the minimum price is not applied, a countervailing charge shall be payable.

## Article 6

1. For wines of fresh grapes falling within CN codes ex 220421 or ex 220429 originating in the Republics concerned, import duties shall be reduced to the levels set out in Annex D. This provision shall apply within the limit of an annual Community tariff quota of 545000 hl . For quantities imported in excess of the quota, the Community shall apply the duty laid down in the Common Customs Tariff.
2. Paragraph 1 shall apply on condition that the price on import into the Community of the wines originating in the Republics concerned, plus the customs duties actually collected, is at all times at least equal to the Community reference prices.

## Article 7

1. The following provisions shall apply to "baby-beef" products defined in Annex E.
2. Within the limits of an initial annual quota of 25000 tonnes, the amount of levy collected on imports into the Community shall be equivalent to $20 \%$ of the basic levy. This provision shall apply on condition that the free-at-frontier offer price, plus customs duty and the reduced levy, is equal to or higher than the Community intervention price for the category AU 3 plus 5\%.
3. Within the limits of a second annual quota of 25400 tonnes, to be used after the quota referred to in paragraph 1 is used up, the amount of levy collected on imports into the Community shall be equivalent to $50 \%$ of the basic levy. This provision shall apply on condition that the free-at-frontier offer price, plus customs duty and the reduced levy, is equal to or higher than the price resulting from application of the standard levy.
4. To help stabilize the Community's internal market, the Commission shall ensure that each Republic concerned maintains an appropriate delivery rate and adopts any measures required to ensure the orderly growth of its exports to the Community, in particular through effective controls on each consignment by means of a certificate stating that the goods originate in and come from the Republic concerned and correspond exactly to the definition in Annex E. The text of this certificate shall be drawn up by the Community.
5. Where the Community market price is less than $98 \%$ of the guide price, paragraphs 2 and 3 shall apply within the limit of a volume of 4200 tonnes per month. Where, during a certain month, this volume has not been entirely used up, the remaining quantity may be carried over only to the following month.
6. The Commission shall ensure that each Republic concerned transmits any relevant information concerning export prices together with the quantities and presentation of the products exported (livestock, carcases or quarters) to the Community authorities.

Article 8
The ceilings, reference quantities and quotas provided for in this Regulation shall apply as a whole to all the Republics to which this Regulation refers, except for the ceilings in Annex C II, which apply solely to the Republics of Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia.

## Article 9

The detailed rules for implementing the agricultural provisions referred to in this Regulation shall be determined by the Commission.

The rules of origin shall be adopted in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 27 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2913/92 establishing the Community Customs Code. 5

## Article 10

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall be applicable from 1 January to 31 December 1995.
This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

## THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,
Whereas the Cooperation Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Slovenia, which was signed on 5 April 1993, 13 the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Slovenia on trade in textile products, which was initialled on 23 July 1993, and Council Regulation (EC) No ... of ... concerning the arrangements applicable to the import into the Community of products originating in the Republics of Croatia, Bosnia-Herzegovina and Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia ${ }^{14}$ provide for exemption on import into the Community from customs duty and charges having an equivalent effect for almost all products falling within Chapters 25 to 97 of the Combined Nomenclature and originating in those Republics; whereas Article 16 of the Cooperation Agreement, Article 15 of the Agreement on trade in textile products and Article 3 of Regulation (EC) No ... stipulate that imports of the products listed in Annexes CI to CV of that Regulation should be subject to annual import ceilings, the exceeding of which may result in re-introduction of the customs duties applicable to third countries; whereas, under these circumstances, the Commission must be kept regularly informed of the trend of imports of the said products; whereas it is therefore necessary for imports of those products to be subject to surveillance; whereas the said tariff ceilings should therefore be opened for 1995;

Whereas Community surveillance may be achieved by means of an administrative procedure based on charging imports of the products in question against the ceilings at Community level as and when those products are entered with the customs authorities for free circulation; whereas this administrative procedure must make provision for the possibility of re-introducing customs duties as soon as the ceilings are reached at Community level;

Whereas this administrative procedure requires close and particularly rapid cooperation between the Member States and the Commission and the latter must in particular be able to follow the progress of quantities charged against the ceilings and keep the Member States informed; whereas this cooperation has to be particularly close since the Commission must be able to take appropriate measures to re-introduce customs duties if one of the ceilings is reached,

## HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

## Article 1

1. From 1 January to 31 December 1995 imports into the Community of certain products originating in the Republics of Croatia, Bosnia-Herzegovina and Slovenia and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and listed in Annexes C I, C II, C III, C IV and C V to Regulation (EC) No ... and in Annex $V$ to the-Agreement-between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Slovenia on trade in textile products shall be subject to ceilings and Community surveillance.
[^14]The description of the products referred to in the first subparagraph, their Combined Nomenclature codes and the corresponding ceilings or sub-ceilings are set out in the said Annexes. In Annex C II, the ceilings are indicated in column 4 (b).

The order numbers and Combined Nomenclature codes for the tariff ceilings opened by virtue of Annex V to the said Agreement with the Republic of Slovenia are indicated in the Annex to this Regulation.
2. The ceilings laid down for certain products listed in Annex C II which have been the subject of an outward processing operation in accordance with the Community rules on economic outward processing are indicated in column 4 (a).
3. Quantities shall be charged against the ceilings or sub-ceilings as and when declarations for release for free circulation are lodged with customs authorities with a movement certificate in accordance with the rules of origin adopted under the procedure laid down in Article 27 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2913/92 of 12 October 1992 establishing the Community Customs Code. ${ }^{15}$

As regards the ceilings established for categories 5, 6, 7, 8, 15 and 16 of column 4 (a) of Annex $C$ II, re-imported goods which have been the subject of an outward processing operation in accordance with the Community rules on economic outward processing may be charged against the respective ceilings only if the movement certificate issued by the competent authorities of the Republic or territory in question contains a reference to the prior authorization provided for by the Community rules on economic outward processing.

Goods may be charged against a ceiling or sub-ceiling only if the movement certificate is presented before the date on which customs duties are re-introduced.

The extent to which the ceilings and sub-ceilings are used up shall be determined at Community level on the basis of the imports charged against them in the manner defined in the first, second and third subparagraphs.

Member States shall periodically inform the Commission of imports charged in accordance with the above procedure; such information shall be supplied in the manner laid down in paragraph 5 .
4. As soon as the ceilings or sub-ceilings have been reached, the Commission may adopt a Regulation re-introducing, until the end of the calendar year, the customs duties actually applied in respect of third countries.
5. Member States shall send the Commission not later than the 15 th day of each month statements of the quantities charged during the preceding month. If the Commission so requests, they shall provide such statements for a period of 10 days and forward them within five clear days of the end of each 10 -day period.

## Article 2

Member States and the Commission shall cooperate closely to ensure that this Regulation is complied with.

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from I January 1995.
This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
