The Financial Controller has approved this proposal, attesting that the appropriations are available at 3 April 1979.

REASONS

In 1978, a subsidy of 131 000 EUA was paid to the European Training and Promotion Centre for Farming and Rural Life (Cepfar). In this way the Centre was able to do its work properly, thanks also to additional financial contributions from the trade organizations themselves.

An appropriation of only 50 000 EUA is entered in the 1979 Budget as it stands, since the appropriations entered in Article 316 could not be increased, as Parliament planned, by amendment because of the special circumstances surrounding the final stage of the budgetary procedure last December.

The Commission has examined Cepfar's programme of activities for 1979 and considers possible a maximum subsidy of 135 000 EUA - slightly more than in 1978 - to enable its activities to remain at a satisfactory level.

The Commission asks the Budgetary Authority to agree to the allocation of an additional 85 000 EUA to Article 316 by means of a transfer from Chapter 101.
