

COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

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Brussels, 10 September 1975

on the application of Article 35 of the Additional Protocol
to the EEC-Turkey Association Agreement

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- 1. Under Article 35 of the Additional Protocol to the EEC-Turkey Association Agreement, a review of agricultural products must be made every two years. Pursuant to this provision, and in the light of the results of the negotiations which led to the signing of the Supplementary Protocol extending the Association to the new Member States, the first review took place in 1973 and will be followed by the second in 1975.
- 2. The first review led to the establishment of arrangements for certain products and to the Community's extension of the concessions to cover other products in the light of the negotiations conducted in the context of the overall Mediterranean approach. Those negotiations have not yet been completed, contrary to the timetable envisaged in 1973. Only the Agreement with Israel has actually entered into force.

 Nevertheless, the conclusion of that Agreement has led Turkey to request the Community to translate into practical terms the offers left in suspense in 1973. At the meeting of the Committee of Association held on 27 June 1975, it was decided that the review should cover all the problems arising at the present time, whether left over from the 1973 review or scheduled for examination under the review to be carried out in 1975.
- 3. These are the circumstances in which the Commission is submitting to the Council the proposals annexed hereto. With reference to these proposals, the Commission would draw the Council's attention to the political importance of a satisfactory conclusion being reached in the negotiations on the application of Article 35 of the Additional Protocol in the present context of relations between the Community and Turkey, particularly with regard to the development of the Association.

This proposal also takes into account:

- 1. the provisions of Article 35;
- 2. Article 11 of Annex No 6 to the Additional Protocol which stipulates that "the Council of Association shall determine the preferential treatment applicable to wine originating in Turkey";
- 3. the discussions held in Ankara in 1973 concerning the first review of agricultural products;
- 4. the work carried out in the context of the overall Mediterranean approach.
