

SALEWSKI, Dr.W.: Director, Investments and Productivity Division

Born Spandau, Berlin, 27.6.99.

- 1917 - 21: studied law and political science, with intermission owing to service in first world war.
- 1921: began work with clerical workers' associations and German Trade Union Federation (Christian union).
- 1923 - 24: financial expert with Farmers' Bank in Berlin.
- 1 year: worked on Berlin Stock Exchange, and as city editor of Buchwald's Stock Exchange reports.
- From 1926: city editor with "Deutscher Handelsdienst" (commercial journal published by Telegrafien-Union, Berlin).
- From 1928: editor of "Westdeutscher Handelsdienst" (West German commercial journal, published by Telegrafien-Union, Essen).
- From 1934: general secretary of Press and literature liaison office for iron, Düsseldorf. Shortly afterwards, in addition, general secretary of the North-West Regional Group of the Iron and Steel Economic Board, Düsseldorf.
- 1943 - 45: head of section in Ministry of Armaments, Berlin.
- From 1945: general secretary of the Iron and Steel Economic Union ("Wirtschaftsvereinigung Eisen- und Stahlindustrie").
- October 1952: started work with the High Authority.
