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## FOREWORD

When looking at the Social Statistics programme in 1971 the Council stressed the need for a better understanding of the position of, and trends in, the labour market. It underlined the importance of assessing what gaps there may be in the statistics available, taking into account the needs of the various users both at Community and national level (Council document no. 1220/71 (SOC 125)). As a result, both to facilitate this assessment, and the use of employment statistics generally, the Statistical Office produced in early 1972 a first edition of the present pamphlet, enumerating the then existing national and community statistics on employment and unemployment, according to standardized format.

With the continuing interest of the Council in this field and the enlargement of the Community it seemed an appropriate time to produce a new edition, which has been prepared according to the same format as the first and refers to the situation in May 1975. The Statistical Office thanks the participating government experts for their help in preparing the pamphlet, without which it would not have been possible to proceed.

Considerable effort has gone into translation but it cannot be precise where words in everyday use are given a narrower definition when used technically. For an authoritative account, recourse may be made to the edition in the language of the country concerned.
