

# Proposal for a COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

amending Council Regulation (EEC) No 103/76 laying down common marketing standards for certain fresh or chilled fish.

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)



#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM


During the period which followed the adoption of Regulation (EEC) No 103/76, the production for human consumption of most of the species listed in Annex B to that Regulation decreased. Hence, in order to protect reserved and exploit the resources of the sea on a more rational basis, it is necessary to ensure that fish which have not yet reached a specific minimum size should be excluded from the market in products intended for human consumption.

Minimum sizes are laid down for all the species listed in Annex B to Regulation (EEC) No 103/76. Herrings from the Baltic are smaller than those caught in other waters. A distinction is therefore made between herring caught in the Baltic Sea and herring caught elsewhere.

This measure will make it possible to economize on EAGGF expenditure and will serve as a basis for the reclassification of different species of fish according to size, category of freshness and packaging under the Regulation fixing the withdrawal price.

Lastly, it is stressed that the introduction of minimum sizes will also apply to products imported from non-member countries.

<u>Financial consequences</u>: would lead to savings in financial compersation for intervention purposes

#### COUNCIL REGULATION EEC

amending Council Regulation (EEC) No 103/76 laying down common marketing standards for certain fresh or chilled fish.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 of 19 January 1976 on the common organization of the market in fishery products (1), and in particular Article 2(3) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas size categories were laid down by Council Regulation (EEC) No 103/76 of 19 January 1976 laying down common marketing standards for certain fresh or chilled fish (2);

Whereas in the light of experience in applying the size categories laid down in Annex B to the said Regulation some changes have proved necessary; whereas, therefore, the said Annex B should be amended accordingly;

Whereas the fixing of common marketing standards should take into account the interest of the Community in conserving fish stocks as far as possible; whereas therefore fish which have not grown to a minimum size must be excluded from the ting for human consumption,

HAS ADOPTED THIS TERRILATION:

## Article 1 '

Annex B to Regulation (EEC) No 103/76 is replaced by the Annex to this Regulation.

### Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
