EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. The Joint Committee between the European Economic Community and the Socialist Republic of Romania, which was established by the Bucharest Agreement of 28 July 1980, held its second meeting in Bucharest on 2 and 3 December 1982.
- 2. Upon completion of the Joint Committee's work the two delegations agreed to recommend to their respective authorities a series of commercial measures to promote the development of trade between the Community and Romania.

The Community delegation's recommendations involve <u>inter alia</u> the following measures:

- (a) liberalizing imports of certain products in certain member States (see draft Regulation in Annex I);
- (b) increasing for 1982 some of the amounts relating to products in Annex II to the Protocol to the Agreement (voluntary restraints). (See draft Regulation in Annex II.)

The adoption of these measures implies the amendment of the Protocol to the industrial Agreement. Moreover, this protocol provides that amendments to the Annexes thereto should be notified by an exchange of letters between the two parties (see Article 4 (2)).

3. Consequently, in accordance with the recommendations of the EEC-Romania
Joint Committee, the Commission proposes that the Council adopt the
Regulations proposed in the annexes.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 3799/81 of 15 December 1981 amending Regulation (EEC) No 3449/80 by way of extending the lists of products originating in Romania in respect of which quantitative restrictions on import into the Community have been eliminated (1) contains the import arrangements for products originating in Romania which have not been liberalized at Community level;

Whereas the Joint Committee established by the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Socialist Republic of Romania of 28 July 1980 (2) met in Bucharest on 2 and 3 December 1982; whereas upon completion of its work it recommended, among other measures, the abolition of quantitative restrictions on the release for free circulation in certain member States of products originating in Romania;

Whereas, following the examination of the measures recommended by the Joint Committee, action should be taken thereon, account being taken in particular of Article 3 (1) of the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Socialist Republic of Romania on trade in industrial products products (3).

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The quantitative restrictions on the release for free circulation of the products originating in Romania listed in the Annex shall be abolished in the Member States referred to alongside each product.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all member States.
