fixing, for the 1976/1977 marketing year, the production aid for tinned pineapple and the minimum price to be paid to pineapple producers

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Council regulation (CEE) No 1929/75 of 22 July 1975 introduced a system of aid for the production of preserved pineapples. In accordance with article 4 of that regulation the Council should fix the aid so as to compensate the difference between the Community offer price and the prices practiced by third country suppliers. The Council should at the same time fix the level of the minimum price payable by the processors to the growers of pineapples.

In the attached proposal for a regulation the aid is calculated having regard to the provisions of the above basic regulation. The price on importation, immediate packing included, in a representative Community market is 40,5 U.C./100 kg. The Community offer price from 1 June 1976 is calculated at 69,3 U.C./100 kg. The aid proposed is consequently 28,8 U.C./100 kg. On the basis of the Community offer price the price payable to growers is fixed at 15 U.C./100 kg.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1929/75 of 22 July 1975 establishing a system of production aid for tinned pineapple (1), and in particular Article 4 (2) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1929/75 establishes a system of production aid for tinned pineapple processed from pineapples harvested in the Community; whereas the object of such aid is to offset the difference between the Community offer price and the prices charged by third countries for tinned pineapple;

Whereas, under Article 3 thereof, the granting of such aid is subject to the payment to producers of fresh pineapples of at least a minimum price; whereas that price must be fixed so as to ensure a fair remuneration to the said producers,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

For the 1976/1977 marketing year, the production aid for tinned pineapple referred to in Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1929/75 shall be 28.8 units of account/100 kilogrammes, including immediate packings.

Article 2

For the 1976/1977 marketing year, the minimum price referred to in Article 3 of the said Regulation shall be 15.0 units of account/100 kilogrammes.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities. It shall be apply with effect from 1 June 1976.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
