Article 264 - Statistical studies and surveys 420 000 EUA

The Financial Controller approved this proposal on 18 November 1980 in accordance with Article 21 (4) of the Financial Regulation and certified that the appropriations are available.

GROUNDS

In the course of the discussions leading to establishment of the 1980 budget, the budgetary authority decided to enter an appropriation of 750.000 EUA under Chapter 100 for a survey on the earnings of permanent workers employed in agriculture in 1980. The Commission's proposal for a Council regulation was forwarded to the Council on 19 June 1980 (COM (80) 335 final).

Talks at budgetary level revealed that, because Germany would not be taking part, the cost of the survey would have to be reviewed. Agreement was finally reached on a survey of 34 800 units at a total cost of 420 000 EUA. The proposal for a regulation on the survey appears on the agenda for the next Council meeting as an A item.

Appropriations to finance this survey should be released without delay, particularly in view of the limited time available for committing the expenditure. The Commission accordingly requests the transfer of 420 000 EUA from Chapter 100 to Article 264, to article to which the expenditure will be charged.
