AMENDMENT TO THE PROPOSAL FOR A COUNCIL REGULATION
DEFINING THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH A PERSON MAY
BE PERMITTED TO MAKE A CUSTOMS DECLARATION

(presented by the Commission to the Council pursuant
to the second paragraph of article 149 of the EEC Treaty)

Explanatory memorandum

Following the opinion of the European Parliament (1) on the proposal for a regulation defining the conditions under which a person may be permitted to make a customs declaration (2) the Commission considers it appropriate to modify its original proposal in conformity with Article 149 second sub paragraph of the Treaty setting up the European Economic Community.

The proposed modification is a drafting improvement and makes no change of substance to the Commission's original proposal.

The proposal for a Council Regulation defining the conditions under which a person may be permitted to make a customs declaration

(Modification proposed in application of Article 149 second sub-paragraph of the EEC Treaty)

The Commission amends its proposal as follows :

- Article 5 - New version

Persons who have committed a serious offence against customs, fiscal or economic legislation may be excluded from the right to declare on behalf of another person.
