EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. Article 10 of Regulation No 136/66/EEC lays down that the Council shall define the principles according to which the subsidy provided for in that Article shall be granted to olive oil producers.
  2. Regulation (EEC) No 3209/73 define the above-mentioned principles for the 1973/1974, 1974/1975 and 1975/1976 olive oil marketing years.  
In anticipation of a general examination of the problems arising in the common organization of the olive oil market, it appears inopportune to change the said principles; hence it is proposed to extend them to cover the 1976/1977 marketing year.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC<sup>(1)</sup> of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organization of the market in oils and fats, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1707/73<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 10 (2) thereof;

Having regard to Council Regulation No 162/66/EEC<sup>(3)</sup> of 27 October 1966 on trade in oils and fats between the Community and Greece, and in particular Article 8 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 3209/73<sup>(4)</sup> of 27 November 1973 on the subsidy for olive oil, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2807/75<sup>(5)</sup>, laid down the principles whereby the subsidy referred to in Article 10 of Regulation No 136/66/EEC should be granted to olive oil producers for the 1973/1974, 1974/1975 and 1975/1976 marketing years; whereas these principles should also cover the 1976/1977 marketing year,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 3209/73 the expression 'For the 1973/74, 1974/75 and 1975/76 marketing years' is replaced by 'For the 1973/74, 1974/75, 1975/76 and 1976/77 marketing years'.

Article 2

The second paragraph of Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) No 3209/73 is replaced by the following :

"Where cultivation declarations have already been submitted during preceding marketing years, they may continue to be regarded as valid for the marketing year 1976/77, except if the producer's holding has undergone such changes as would alter its potential for producing olives and oil."

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 November 1976.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
