#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

As the Commission has already pointed out to the Council<sup>(1)</sup>, as a result of the drought during the 1976 season, there is a serious supply problem in the Community regarding products for use as animal feed. In addition to the measures already adopted and in particular those designed to discourage exports of straw and fodder products<sup>(1)</sup>, the Commission considers it necessary to facilitate the access to the Community market of substitute products which can be used for animal feeding or be incorporated in compound feedingstuffs. A temporary total suspension of the Common Customs Tariff duties applicable to those products may ease the Community supply situation and thereby prevent further increases in products costs, which constitute one of the causes of a rise in the cost of living.

The proposed measure is therefore intended to offset temporarily the harmful effects of the drought in the sector in question; such a measure of an essentially provisional nature should normally have been taken under the powers conferred upon the Council by Articles 40 and 43 and in accordance with the procedure laid down in those Articles, in particular after consulting the European Parliament. It should be pointed out, however, that the proposed Commission procedure which, in emergencies such as this, would enable the necessary measures to be taken rapidly, has not yet been adopted  $\binom{3}{2}$ .

In these circumstances the Commission considers that it should propose to the Council the tariff measure contained in the attached Regulation, subject to its being subsequently inserted in the common agricultural policy.

### . PROPOSAL

for Council Regulation (EEC)

temporarily suspending application of the Common Customs Tariff duties on certain agricultural products for use as feedingstuffs

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 103 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas the drought in 1976 has severely reduced the availability in the Community of a number of products normally used for cattle feed; whereas this situation has led to an increased demand for substitute products for use in feeding animals or for incorporation in compound feed; whereas as a result the prices for these products on the Community market have risen to a degree which appreciably increases production costs and is indirectly likely to increase the cost of living;

Whereas to forestall such a development and increase supplies of these products on the Community market, it is necessary that the Common Customs Tariff duties on these products should be totally suspended;

Whereas the Buddenness of the situation with which the Community is confronted, the urgency of the measures to be taken and their temporary nature and the absence of any provision in the Regulation on the common organization of the market in certain products listed in Annex II to the Treaty for dealing with such a situation with the necessary speed may be taken to justify recourse to Article 103 of the Treaty as an exceptional measure, subject to later integration of this measure into the common agricultural policy,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

## Article 1

Until 31 March 1977 the Common Customs Tariff duties on the products listed in the Annex hereto shall be totally suspended.

## Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
