Bärbel (Barbara) Jacob is the Deputy Head of the Delegation of the Commission of the European Communities in Washington, D.C. She joined the Delegation in September 1982 as Economic and Commercial Counselor.

Miss Jacob was born in 1940 in Krefeld, West Germany where she completed her secondary education. (Krefeld is the home of the first German settlers to arrive in the U.S. in 1683.) She graduated from the University of Munich in 1964 with a Masters in Economics. She also holds degrees from the Institut d' Etudes Politiques, Paris and the College of Europe in Bruges.

She joined the European Communities in 1966 and worked in several of its institutions, including the European Parliament, the Economic and Social Committee and the Commission.
