Proposal for a
COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

concerning the import of certain viticultural
products originating in Greece into the three new
Member States

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

1. For the products falling within Common Customs Tariff heading No 22.05, originating in Greece, the new Member States shall open import tariff quotas equal to the quantities set out below and at the rates of the duty applied by those Member States on 1 January 1975 to imports from the Community as originally constituted:

United Kingdom :	2.000 hl.
Denmark :	200 hl.
Ireland :	200 hl.

2. These quotas shall be valid for importations effected from 1 January 1977 to 28 April 1977.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
