COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

on charging the levy applicable to certain live sheep and goats

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,
and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) N° 1837/80¹ introduced a system for trade
with non-member countries in sheepmeat and goatmeat; whereas the said system
includes a levy on live sheep and goats;

Whereas, until such time as arrangements can be concluded with certain non-
member countries which traditionally export live sheep and goats to the
Community, the levy on the said products should be restricted within a
quantity limit to be determined for each country of origin,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The levy on products within subheading 01.04 B of the Common Customs Tariff
shall be restricted to 10 % ad valorem, within a quantity limit to be
determined for each country of origin.

Article 2

Detailed rules for the application of this Regulation shall be drawn up in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 26 of Regulation (EEC) N° 1837/80.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 20/10/ 1980. It shall apply until implementation of the voluntary restraint agreements with the non-member countries in question, and until 31 December 1981 at the latest.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
