- 1941-1945 Embassy Counsellor at the German Embassy in Ankara.
- 1947-1949 Joint editor of science, economic and political publications.
- 1950 Served in the Economic Division of the Federal Foreign Ministry.

- 1953-1954 Head of Division.
- 1954 Ambassador in Indonesia.
- 1958 Joined the staff of the E.E.C. Commission.
