Richard V. Allen, Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs, has been President of Potomac International Corporation, a Washington, D.C. consulting firm (1972-1980). He also served as Deputy Assistant to the President of the United States and Deputy Executive Director of the Council on International Economic Policy, the White House (1971-1972); and Senior Staff Member, the National Security Council (1969).

Prior to government service, he was a Senior Staff Member at the Hoover Institution on War, Revolution, and Peace, Stanford University and The Center for Strategic and International Studies, Georgetown University.

Mr. Allen holds B.A. and M.A. degrees from the University of Notre Dame and studied at the Universities of Freiburg and Munich in Germany. His Board memberships include the Intercollegiate Studies Institute; the United States Strategic Institute; the Center for Strategic and International Studies, Georgetown University; The Committee on the Present Danger (Executive Committee); and St. Francis Preparatory School (Pennsylvania).

He was a member of the Republican National Committee's Advisory Council on National Security and International Affairs, as well as Chairman of its Subcommittee on Intelligence.
