Explanatory Memorandum

Regulation (EEC) No. 1196/81 establishes a system of aid for bee-keeping in respect of the 1981/82, 1982/83 and 1983/84 marketing years. For the 1981/82 marketing year, applications for aid shall be submitted not later than 31 July 1981.

In certain Member States, administrative problems have arisen as regards keeping this deadline. A postponement of the time limit until 30 September 1981 is therefore proposed.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Articles 42 and 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament (1)

Whereas the implementation of the measures provided for in Council Regulation (EEC) No 1196/81⁽²⁾ is causing administrative difficulties; whereas the date for the submission of applications for aid for the 1981/82 marketing year should therefore be deferred;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In the second subparagraph of Article 4(1) of Regulation (EEC) No. 1196/81, "31 July 1981" is hereby replaced by "30 September 1981".

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from 1 August 1981.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
