EMILE A CAMPO

Director General for Industrial and Competition Policies
at the Council of Ministers in Brussels, Belgium

Mr. A Campo was born in Siantar, Indonesia on
December 13, 1924.

After attending primary school in Indonesia and
secondary school in the Netherlands, he received university
degrees in Philosophy from Leiden in the Netherlands, the
London School of Economics, the Sorbonne and College de
France in Paris.

From 1952-57, he was instructor of public administration
at the Institute of Social Studies in The Hague, and from
1957-61, he was secretary and manager of the Department of
Mechanical Engineering at the Technological University of
Eindhoven in the Netherlands.

Mr. A Campo has been with the Secretariat General
of the Council of Ministers of the European Community in
Brussels since 1961, first as Head of Division, then Director,
and since January, 1976, as Director General for the
European Community Industrial and Competition Policies.

Mr. A Campo is of Dutch nationality.
