

HUBERT EHRLING

Mr. Hubert EHRLING is a member of the Commission of the European Economic Community and is a specialist in the legal aspects of trade within the Common Market countries.

Born in Germany on December 12, 1912, he studied law and modern languages at the universities of Freiburg, Munich, Cologne and Muenster.

Following the war, Mr. Ehring resumed his career within the Federal court system, remaining with the Federal Ministry of Law until 1952, when he was appointed legal advisor in the Federal Ministry of Economics.

From 1955 to 1958 he was head of the legal department of the Council of Ministers of the European Coal and Steel Community. He held that position until he was appointed to the European Economic Community in 1958.
